

For over forty-five years, Burbank Housing has helped fill a gap in housing affordability with over 70 properties across North Bay providing homes to 10,000 residents. While we are proud of that achievement, we at Burbank Housing know affordable housing alone is not enough for low-income people to achieve housing stability and enable families and individuals to move up and out of poverty.

Beyond housing, we are bringing vital services that enhance the well-being of our residents. Through partnerships with great organizations across the region, we provide a host of services and programming at our properties at no cost to the residents.

Programming is specific to the respective needs of each property and community, some of which include food access services, after-school programs for youth, adult education programs, health & wellness programs and a variety of seasonal family events
